The Romanian Pavilion at Milan Expo 2015 revolved around the coexistence of modern technology and urban lifestyle connected with the nature around it. It consists of two main layers: the ground floor, with media-partition walls, some of which are rotary, granting greater flexibility for the entire space, and the first floor, housing the restaurant, showcasing the contrast between the tradition wooden floor, wooden beams, reed roofing and and contemporary media displays, glass furnishings and stainless steel cables. The merger between these elements emphasized the connection between nature, tradition, technology and harmony, while also making these contrasting elements easily distinguishable.
